And, most importantly, you will have the right to nominate and vote for the prestigious Chesley Awards (named for the great astronomical artist Chesley Bonestell) awarded each year to recognize individual works and achievements during the previous year. Any artist may be nominated and win, but only ASFA members may vote.

Upcoming Conventions Listings, which includes information on the major SF & F art shows throughout the world.

Ongoing Discussions covering hot topics such as the impact of computer-generated art, copyrights, prints and printers, electronic rights, and most importantly, any subject brought up by ASFA members.

If you are an SF or Fantasy Artist, you can't afford to miss out on this opportunity for inside information that could make a difference in your success.

If you are a Fan, Collector, or Art Director, you won't want to miss bios of your favorite artists and tips for more successful buying and show strategies.

All Memberships except Lifetime are for the period of one year, based on the month you join.

Regular:

Associate:

Identical to Regular membership, except this member must reside with a Regular Member and has access to said member's copies of all ASFA publications. An Associate Member will not receive separate copies of any ASFA publications.

Foreign Memberships:

Foreign Memberships are identical to Regular memberships; foreign members may vote, nominate, hold office, serve on committees, and have all the rights and

privileges of full membership, including receipt of all ASFA publications.

Note: Payments must be made in U.S. funds.

Corporate:

Any corporation, institution or organization with an interest in art and the purposes of ASFA.

Lifetime:

Lifetime Members have all the rights and privileges of a Regular Member, but do not have to renew their membership each year.
